Had received your e-mail today and sending some attachment's. I've sent you a copy that all Sitting Members should have received, which arrived and signed by Paul in Parliament, around 10.30 am on the 14th July 2017.

Out of the 121 Sitting Members we only had two reply. We got in-touch with other Members to see if they received them. This they did not.

The question is. What happened to them all, for this was the procedure we needed to go down, so that all Sitting Members were to have an individual hard copy. This was registered on the 13th July 2017 at 11.48 am with the NZ Post Rotorua. We also rang to make sure they were delivered and been deposited into each of their mail box, which he confirmed they had. We e-mailed the Speaker of the House the same document for the Sitting Members on the 11th August 2017. We have not received a reply.

Finding it amazing that no recognition has been replied towards our W.W.1 Veterans, naming my grandfather, William Magnus Peterson, whom I speak on behalf. Also the report from the Ministry of Justice dated the 14 Feb 2017, here they were able to put their own personal opinion of events that occurred in history, and then have the cheek to publish it, this was without merit and discrimination towards a Veteran.

I thought you would be aware of the treasonous acts that's been raised in Parliament, for the illegal bankruptcy on Soldier'e Holding's by Government, where Government have refused to address the serious issues that's been raised in regards to our claim. When treason has been raised in Parliament, this must be addressed immediately.
